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



- Collaboration and coordination of career education programs among colleges in each identified region;
- Regional strategies to reduce employment and equity gaps; Page 7 of 28 June 2021 Regional Collaboration and Coordination Grant
- Capture and dissemination of valuable, region-specific employer, industry, and student success data;
- Develop strategies and structures that provide comprehensive supports to serve part-time and adult learners; and
- Evolution of current regional governance structures and employer engagement functions that are much more inclusive.

Expanded Uses of SWP Funding

The Fiscal Year 2023 – 2024 enacted State budget included expanded uses of SWP funding as outlined in Education Code section 88825. SWP funds apportioned directly to a community college district may also be used for all of the following:

- Providing funds for student grants to cover fees for third-party certification and licensing
- Enhancing student services to support retention, work experience, and job placement
- Providing students with an integrated educational program that connects academic curricula to applied and experiential learning in the workplace, including, but not limited to, work-based learning programs and models.
