 - Intersegmental mapping part of conversation as well
 - More pathways for dual enrollment
 - Vision 2030 <u>Activity Feedback & Responses</u>
 - **Baccalaureate Degree Program** important equity issue (area focus). Duplication issue with CSUs - approved by not offered (up to 5 years to launch) 20 applications last cycle, new cycle due Jan 2024.



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- Common Course Numbering CCCAOE no official position. Really about equity and transferability. Fall 2027. Needs a systemic approach (CSU and UC involved)
- AB 928 Increase transfer rates
- California Community College Association for Occupational Education (CCCAOE)- Michael Hoffman, Regional VP for CCCAOE, at Moorpark College.

- Career Connect & Student Employment Paula Hodge
 - Quarterly Reporting for EE
 - Focusing on California employers
- CTE Faculty Liaison Nancy Jo Ward
 - Still working to identify a CTE Liaison at Moorpark and Cuesta colleges
 - Allan Hancock College specific:
 - Revamp Program Review Process (helps with CTE faculty; one person shows).
 - Will help other colleges
 - Established an Innovative Project Fund
- California Consortium for Public Health Informatics and Technology (CCPHIT) Celine Park, Director of Employer Engagement at SBCC
 - Public Health IT (Event in Kern County CC): Emerging field & developing occupational area with no specific standard occupation classification (SOC) code designated for PHIT workers. Lack of SOC code means LMI are limited in job skill requirements.
 - Futuro Health sponsored To fill the gap, Futuro undertook a multipronged scan of LMI to design curricula to help students acquire skills in PHIT jobs.
 - SBCC is a beta for this project as leader in the online HIT certificate program - Micro-regional State initiative. Goal is to support our network of healthcare providers by delivering the online curriculum modules to all 58 counties and 116 colleges. SBCC is looking into implementation.
 - Looking to making national project

- K16 Collaborative Holly Nolan Chavez
 - \$18.1 million grant application to support regional K16 integration with a focus on equity.
 - Serves the six county central coast CERF region (Monterey, Santa Cruz, San Benito, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, and Ventura).
 - Partners include K12, Community College, California State Universities, and University of California.
 - Draft proposal is prepared and will be submitted next week.
 - All community colleges in the CERF region had opportunity to participate in the proposal planning.
 - Awards expected in late October.
- Baccalaureate Degree Program Holly Nolan Chavez
 - Two colleges in our region submitting applications this fall.
 - A presentation from Allan Hancock College will take place at the November meeting.
