Simulation Experience Overview

Day 1

Assess and stabilize the motor accident victim and transfer to the ER

Students worked with O2 devices, splints, intravenous catheters and foley catheter

Day 2

Treated a ventilator patient in the ICU

Learned about sepsis

Students worked with endotracheal tubes, chest tubes and blood administration

Day 3

Performed CPR and assisted with post resuscitation care

Students worked with crash cart, IV medications and BLS

Day 4

Treated patient on Medical Surgical floor

Learned about antibiotics and discharge planning

This course will provide students a real life experience in the hospital setting. Students will take part in a simulation using a high fidelity manikin. Each meeting, the patient's condition will progress and students are required to treat the patient accordingly. The students will be assigned a specific occupation and learn specific skills for that occupation. Each student will be paired up with a medical professional. The students will work as a team to treat the patient. Students also will complete a career presentation as the culminating project.

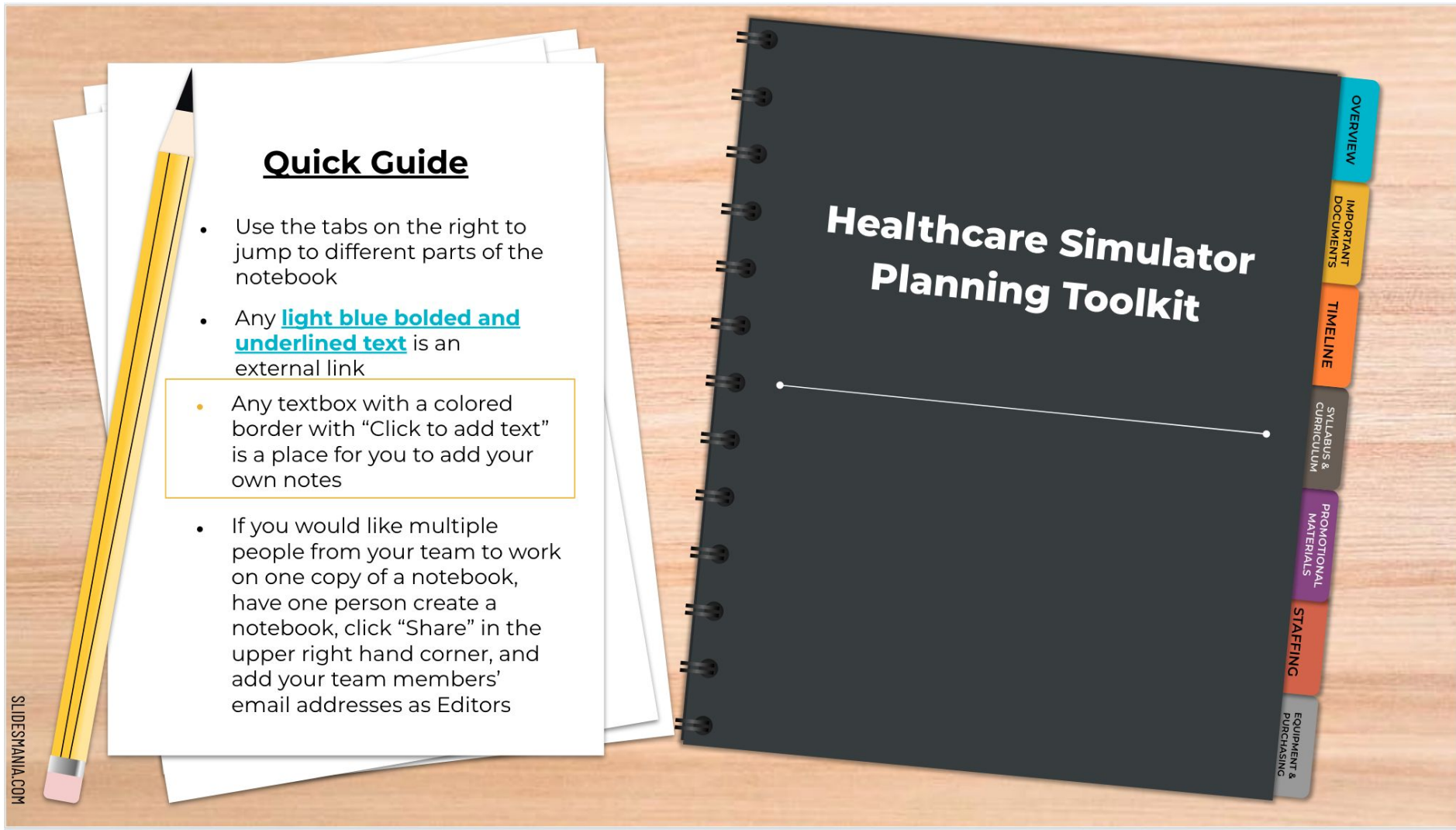
