Policy Summit

Eight members from the region participated in the CCCAOE Policy Summit Feb. 20-21 in Sacramento. They were among 55 people participating from across the state. The region's representatives were:

Participants were assigned into three-member teams for appointments with legislators and legislative staff members. Key discussion points including seeking support for AB 1370 (Ta) to reauthorize the Economic and Workforce Development Act. The act includes funding for regional consortium efforts statewide and the employer engagement efforts supported by the Regional Collaboration and Coordination grant.

Participants also alerted staffers and legislators to SB 895 (Roth) which would create a bachelor degree in nursing pilot program for 15 community college campuses in the state.
