
#### **Health Information Management**


## Regional Workforce Need (COE, August 2023)

In the South Central Coast region, the number of jobs related to Health Information Management are **expected to increase** for Medical and Health Service Managers.

• Health Information Management is anticipated to experience a **low risk of automation**.

• In 2021 there were 438 regional completions in programs related to the occupations identified as aligned with Health Information Management and 600 openings, indicating an **undersupply**.

- Typical entry-level education is a bachelor's degree.
- 71% of students are **employed within a year** after completing a program.
- 91% of students were part-time, 11% skill builders, 37% first-generation, and 87% economically disadvantaged.
