A bill to expand the use of SWP funds to support work-based learning opportunities, including paid internships, has moved forward. AB 323 by Assemblymember Fong made it through the Assembly and has been heard in the Senate Education Committee and sent to the Appropriations Committee. The legislation directs the chancellor's office to rewrite its guidelines for SWP funds to allow districts to use funds for work-based learning.
