Why This Framework Matters

- Aligns the South Central Coast region with CCCCO's Vision 2030 priorities
- Ensures equitable access, career-aligned pathways, and community partnerships
- Provides a structured, phased approach for sustainable transformation
- Supports data-informed decision-making to close equity gaps
- Prepares students for transfer, career success, and lifelong learning
- This approach is a roadmap to accomplish our goals and not anything being mandated by the CO

Phase A: Foundations & Infrastructure

- Focus: Laying the groundwork for equitable access and career-aligned programs
- Key Actions:
 - Establish K-12 partnerships for dual enrollment and outreach
 - Launch bilingual community awareness campaigns
 - Build employer advisory boards
 - Implement DegreeWorks & Program Mapper
 - Develop regional CPL policies and training
- Measurable Outcomes: 3 new DE partnerships/district, 50% DegreeWorks adoption

Phase B: Capacity Building & Expansion

- Focus: Scaling strategies that address equity gaps and workforce alignment
- Key Actions:
 - Expand internships & apprenticeships
 - Increase structured WBL in CTE programs
 - Develop bachelor's degree proposals
 - Enhance auto-awarding of degrees & CPL
 - Implement regional outreach & recruitment
 - Measurable Outcomes: 20% growth in DE, 30% CTE WBL participation

Phase C: Innovation & Systems Integration

- Focus: Leveraging technology and data for equity & effectiveness
- Key Actions:
 - Standardize Al-driven early alert systems
 - Integrate transcript evaluation & CPL tracking
 - Expand DegreeWorks, TES, CRM adoption
 - Launch regional equity-focused dashboards
 - Train faculty/staff in Al & CPL tools
- Measurable Outcomes: 100% Al adoption, regional credit tracking

Phase D: Policy Integration & Sustainability

- Focus: Institutionalizing policies & ensuring long-term funding
- Key Actions:
 - Evaluate Vision 2030 strategies
 - Secure long-term funding
 - Embed CPL & WBL in governance
 - Develop permanent employer-sector consortia
 - Recognize leading colleges
- Measurable Outcomes: Statewide adoption, sustained funding
