- **California Community College Association for Occupational Education (CCCAOE)-Michael Hoffman, Regional VP for CCCAOE, at Moorpark College**
 - Nursing funding question: \$60 million from SWP (Can't spend the money fast enough). Significant impact on other CTE programs and innovation. Need to advocate for clinical time at all of the public hospitals. Regional governance structure blindsided by this allocation without consultation regarding needs. No input on what really needed.
 - SB323 – passed, now the regulations have to change to allow paid internships starting July 1, 2026 (FY 2027). Optional use of funds.
- **Baccalaureate Degree Program - Robert Cabral (Co-Chair of CCCBDP statewide committee)**
 - Six BDPs in our region
 - Welcome new members, one hour/month
 - Share info in real time
 - Reps from CO, researcher from UC Davis
 - Round 8 -10 applications, 7 will move forward
 - Foundation has Community of Practice
 - National meeting in Long Beach – GET ADDITIONAL INFO
