REGIONAL COLLABORATION AND COORDINATION (RCC) GRANT – Regional Fiscal Agent

- Transition planning in progress between Santa Barbara City College (SBCC) and Ventura County Community College District (VCCCD).
- SBCC will keep all existing contracts with Community College (CC) and K12 (K12 SWP Rounds 6-8, CC SWP Rounds 8-10, the RCC EWD through close out of the Round on 5-year grant) and the close out of TAP/PC Year 7.) VCCCD will take over all new contracts starting July 1, 2026.
- Community College Regional Fiscal Transition Meeting was held on April 16 at VCCCD.
- **April 29, 2026 K12 SWP Regional Fiscal Transition Meeting (In-person at VCCCD Board Room from 10 am – 2 pm)**. Zoom option is also available: <https://vcccd-edu.zoom.us/j/81886455839>
- **RCC ECONOMIC AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT (EWD):**
 - **25/26 is the final year of this 5-year RCC Grant. The expenditure period for all years of funding HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO DEC 31, 2026. Awaiting Facesheet from the CCCC.**
- **REMINDER:** First In First Out (FIFO) – expend earliest allocations first with each allocation year reported on separately.
- **QUARTERLY REPORTS:** Due on the 10th of the month following the end of each quarter.
- **INVOICING PROCESS:**
 - For each Allocation Year:**
 - 70% Advance Payment (significant progress must be made in spending the previous years' allocation prior to payment of the 70% Advance of the following year's allocation.)
 - Up to 20% Progress Payment (20% Progress Invoice with general ledger showing 70% expended and all reporting complete)
 - Minimum of 10% Final Invoice with general ledger showing final expenditures and all quarterly fiscal reporting is complete.

REGIONAL STRONG WORKFORCE PROGRAM (SWP)

- **ROUND 10 (25/26) REMINDER:** ENSURE ALL REGIONAL PLANS IN APPROVED AND FUNDS BUDGETED IN NOVA (CONFIRM WITH DASHBOARD) PRIOR TO SUBMITTING 70% ADVANCE PAYMENT.
- **ROUND 9 (24/25) REMINDER - NO EXTENSIONS (ENDS JUNE 30, 2026)** – CCCC memo expected soon.
- **ROUND 8 (23/24): EXTENSIONS GRANTED – FUNDS EXPIRE JUNE 30, 2026.**
- **EXTENSIONS:**
 - **Round 8 FY 2023/24:** Extensions beyond 12/31/2025 expire on 6/30/2026. **Final Fiscal reporting due by 8/15/2026.**
 - **Round 9 FY 2024/25:** Extensions are *not* being considered for the allocation expenditure timeframe. **Funds expire on 6/30/2026. Final fiscal reporting is due by 8/15/2026.**
 - Unallocated and unspent balances are reported to the Legislative Analyst Office and Department of Finance as requested. Please ensure all fiscal reporting is up to date in NOVA.
- **REPORTING:**
 - We encourage using additional comment section to add details and narrative to use in final report
 - **CCCCO is looking for additional detail plans and in Q4 and Final Narrative reports that tie back to the regional plan and project plan outcomes.**

 - Please be sure that all regional funds are budgeted in NOVA and plans are certified before submitting for the 70% Advance payments and ensure that all reporting (including the Final Report Narrative) is up to date before submitting invoices for progress and/or final payments.
