- The K-12 SWP Round 9 Review Team has finalized voting on both the Round 9 guidance and the slate of new and returning Selection Committee members.



- The Round 9 Selection Committee Kickoff is scheduled for May 8, marking the formal launch of this next phase of regional investment and review.
- On April 2, a cross-sector Environmental Education Professional Development was successfully hosted by College of the Canyons, in partnership with Creeklands, providing curriculum-based training aligned to K-12 pathways.
- K14 TAP and Pathway Coordinators are actively engaging CTE counselors through “CTE 101” sessions, strengthening shared understanding of pathways, access points, and student supports across systems.
- The CTE Dual Enrollment Research Project continues to move forward:
 - Pathway Coordinators are supporting the compilation of district and college contacts.
 - The research team is analyzing patterns and trends across each community college service area.
 - A comprehensive report, including tailored guidance for each college, is on track for completion by June 30, 2026, with a regional presentation planned for Summer 2026.

Regional Program Recommendations and Requests for Labor Market Information (see below)

Applied Cyber Network Operations (ACNO) B.S., Moorpark College - Original Date Reviewed: January 20, 2023. The program was recommended by unanimous vote on April 22, 2026, and was originally presented to the region in 2023.

Robert Cabral led a discussion about Moorpark College's recent approval of the Applied Cyber Network Operations BDP, a cycle 2 application. The Bachelor's Degree Program (BDP) was a prior agenda item at the January 2023 meeting that was presented, reviewed, discussed, and supported. Cabral advised the current process for newer cycle BDPs is to receive consortium program recommendation. Cabral stated

this item was discussed at the April 15, 2026 SCCRC Steering Committee and the April 16, 2026 SCCRC Executive Council. Both committee and council recommended the program to be added to the April 22, 2026 consortium agenda for recommendation.

The ACNO BS program was reaffirmed with a vote of "recommendation".
