Minutes

- 8:30 – 9:00 am** **Pre-meeting - CTE Deans Only**
- 9:00 – 9:10 am** **Welcoming, Introductions, & Updates** – *Robert Cabral, Acting Associate Vice Chancellor, VCCCD*
Welcoming from VCCCD – *Cynthia Herrera, Vice Chancellor, VCCCD*
Robert welcomed consortium members and introduced key staff supporting the SCCRC transition. He provided an update on the transition to Ventura County Community College District oversight, emphasizing transparency, improved communication, and continued support throughout the leadership transition. Members were informed that the SCCRC Vice President position is expected to be filled by November 2026. Until then, Robert will continue supporting consortium leadership.
Cynthia Herrera discussed the consortium's future, emphasizing continued collaboration, regional alignment, and support for student pathways.

- 9:20 – 9:35 am** **Interim Fiscal Agent Directors Update** – *Dr. Devin Daugherty (SBCCD) and Miranda Donlon (VCCCD)*
- **Community College Strong Workforce Program (SWP)**
Devin Daugherty provided updates on Strong Workforce Program (SWP) fiscal reporting and grant closeout activities. He is supporting the closeout of regional consortium grants managed by Santa Barbara City College, a process expected to continue over the next three years.
For SWP Round 8, colleges with extensions were reminded to complete reporting requirements as soon as possible, upload financial documentation into NOVA, and submit materials for final approval. For SWP Round 9, extension requests will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, and colleges are encouraged to reach out for guidance if needed. For SWP Round 10, colleges were reminded to complete required reporting and supporting documentation, with assistance available for NOVA submissions and reimbursement requests.



- **K12 Strong Workforce Program (K12 SWP)**

Devin shared with the team that he is working with Giselle Bice to identify remaining K-12 Strong Workforce funds and develop a plan for regional allocation and spending. Once remaining funds are identified, Giselle will help coordinate next steps for distribution and utilization of resources. She will continue to be a key point of contact for K-12 fiscal questions and support.

- **Regional Coordination and Collaboration (RCC) Grant**

Miranda Donlon provided updates on fiscal activities. Employer engagement agreements have been distributed to college business offices, and the K-12 Pathway Coordinator and K-14 TAP funding agreements have received Board approval and have also been distributed. The two pots of unspent K-12 funds will be brought forward for Board approval in August. Additionally, the allocation memo for Strong Workforce Community College Round 11 has been received, and Robert will help move the allocation process through the appropriate committees.

- **Welcome Imelda Luna, SCCRC Financial Analyst (VCCCD)!**

Miranda Donlon introduced Imelda Luna as the new SCCRC financial analyst and primary point of contact for fiscal support. Miranda will continue providing fiscal oversight while supporting Imelda's transition into the role. Imelda's contact information will be shared with consortium members.

K12 Strong Workforce Program Update – *Giselle Bice, K14 TAP*

Giselle Bice provided an overview of the K-12 Strong Workforce Program Round 9 priorities, highlighting stronger alignment between K-12 pathways and community college programs, updated application requirements, and clearly defined partnership commitments. Giselle noted that upcoming engagement sessions will provide additional application guidance, and presentation materials will be distributed to consortium members.

Kristina Barckley provided an update on the Launch Apprenticeship Network, highlighting its statewide expansion, new apprenticeship and pre-apprenticeship program standards aligned with regional priority sectors, and available technical assistance for colleges.

Kristina updated the team on Launch's partnership with AMR to support paramedic apprenticeships through community colleges. Members discussed the importance of dedicated apprenticeship coordination and employer partnerships, and Kristina encouraged colleges to utilize Launch resources and technical support.
