AFMT Program Update

Scheduled Graduation for the AFMT Program is **June 2019**

Projected that **13 AFMT students** will meet the Graduation requirements for the June 2019 graduation.

AFAB Rapid Training Classes

Between Summer 2017 and Spring 2018, the total duplicated enrollment in Palmdale AFAB courses was 381 students and unduplicated enrollment is 216 students.

- The number of AFAB sections was 17 (plus 3 sections in Summer 2018).

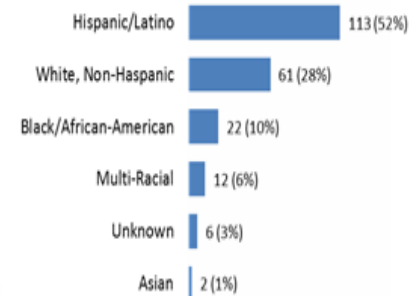
Every fifth student enrolled in the AFAB accelerated courses is *female*.

AFAB Rapid Training Classes

The majority of the students enrolled in AFAB 8-week courses in Palmdale are *Hispanic/Latino* (52%). *White* (28%) and *African-American* (10%) are the next two major groups.



AFAB Rapid Training Classes

AFAB Participants enrolled via the Americas Job Centers of California (WIOA Funding), since January 2016.

Total amount of people trained January 2016 - Present): 425 (with an additional 40 in training for the Summer Session that began June 2018)

Total amount of people hired by Northrop Grumman: 364

Those placed at companies other than NG: 37 (BYD, Kinkysharyo, ADI, General Atomics, Morton Manufacturing, Lance Campers, etc.)

Overall placement rate for the program: 94%



AFAB Rapid Training Classes

Total amount of Females placed: 78

Total amount of Veterans placed: 29

Total amount of low income individuals placed (CalFresh / BOG Waiver Recipients): 255

Total amount of minority students placed: 206

Total Homeless students placed: 18

Average Starting Wage: \$16.87 per hour.



AFAB Rapid Training Classes

In addition, the AFAB program was just awarded a Gold Star by the Chancellor's Office.

Programs earning a Gold Star recognition have graduates that have attained all of the following thresholds for economic mobility:

- An increase in earnings by 50% or more
- Attainment of the regional living wage by 70% or more
- 90% or more are employed in a job similar to their field of study

The Aircraft Fabrication and Assembly Technician Program attainment:

- 94% increase in earnings
- 78% of students attained the regional living wage
- 100% of students are employed in a job similar to their field of study
