1. **Strong Workforce Program:** Beginning in program year 2018-19, each Strong Workforce Program project will report on project expenditures-to-date on a quarterly basis, due 45 days after the end of each fiscal quarter.

2. **August 31, 2018:** REGIONAL CONSORTIA 1B: Both Final expenditure reporting and Final Narrative report due.
3. **August 31, 2018:** Title 1-C and CTE Transitions YTD Final Report of Expenditures must first be certified by the district CBO as these fiscal reports populate the Final Report System Section IV, Part A - Budget Summary by District. The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) must then certify the 2017-2018 Perkins Title-IC Online Final Report **(by Friday, August 31, 2018)**. **PASSWORDS ARE THE SAME FOR THE FINAL REPORTING AS WAS ORIGINALLY ASSIGNED TO EACH DISTRICT FOR ALL EXPENDITURE REPORTING.** IF YOU ARE A NEW CTE DEAN PLEASE CONTACT YOUR PROGRAM MONITOR, [KATIE FAIRES](#) FOR PASSWORD ASSISTANCE.

5. **Perkins V Interim year** will be **July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020** and the new plan will start on July 1st 2020.

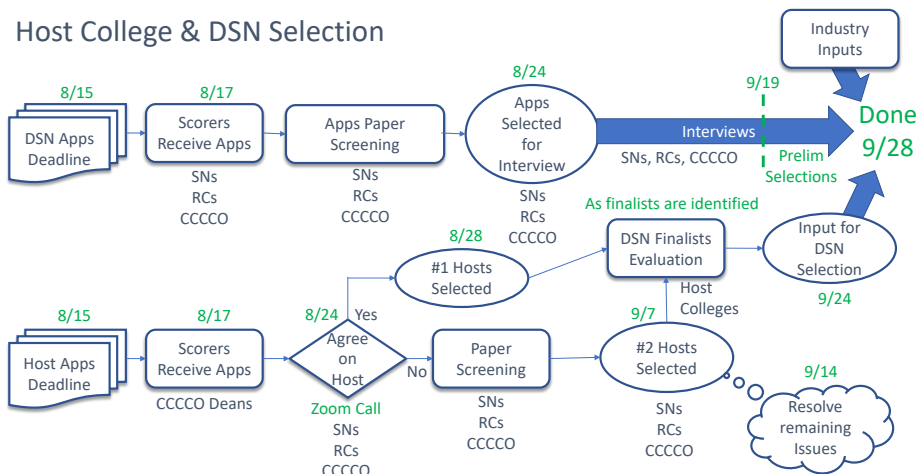
