

# SUMMER EXTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY Summer 2016



Through the SB1070 Regional Career Pathways Grant for the South Central Coast Region, a \$400 stipend per person is being offered for faculty/ high school teachers to complete an externship at an industry within your career pathway area/ discipline and develop curriculum for a classroom activity. The goal is to share new industry information with students across the region for emerging and priority sectors.

The mandatory guidelines are as follows:

- 1) You will find your own placement with an industry/ business that is new to you but within your sector.
- 2) Minimum of one day will need to be spent on-site at the industry/ business location, conducting interviews and observing activities. Alternatively, you can spend two half days with two different companies with the same parameters.
- 3) We encourage faculty/ high school teachers in the same career pathway area to attend as a team to maximize the benefit to their students while minimizing disruption to the industry/business partner.
- 4) The curriculum to be developed would comprise:
  - a) A student classroom activity lasting for a minimum of one high school class period or one hour of a college class. Curriculum must be submitted in the format of a lesson plan as attached with student learning outcomes and instructions for an interactive activity including supplemental materials such as a PowerPoint presentation.
  - b) Labor market information for your students based on the employer's hiring criteria for new employees i.e. salary, experience/ training required, employability skills, number of openings, career pathways within the company etc. This may be submitted as a Word document or PowerPoint.

This curriculum will be made available to other instructors across the region by being posted on the South Central Coast Regional Consortium website ([www.sccrcolleges.org](http://www.sccrcolleges.org)). Curriculum is to be delivered at a maximum of 2 weeks after completion of externship.

- 5) Send a thank you note to industry/ business within 3 days of completing your externship.
- 6) Complete the application information and return to me no later than May 20, 2016.
- 7) Report how you intend to integrate what you have learned into the curriculum.
- 8) We will follow up next semester to find out how well your new classroom activity worked with your students.
