Strong Workforce Program (SWP) Updates

1. K12 Pathways Coordinators (PC)

All 6 college districts have LEA hosts:

- Santa Barbara County Office of Ed serving Allan Hancock and SBCC areas
- Ventura County Office of Ed serving the 3 colleges in Ventura County
- Hart District serving College of the Canyons area
- Antelope Valley High School District serving AVC area
- San Luis Obispo Office of Ed serving the Cuesta area

Onboarding and training will be held June 2 and 3 at UCLA Conference Center at Lake Arrowhead. Lyla Edington is statewide K14 TAP/K12 PC Lead.

Rancho Santiago Community College District is the Fiscal Agent for all of the K12 PCs in the state.

2. K14 Technical Assistance Provider (TAP)

The job has been posted at COC. Regional Chair will be sending an email out an email to the region and the K12 listserv with the details on how to apply.





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3. K12 SWP

Selection Committee has determined funding amounts for this fiscal year. The Chancellor's Office will send an Intent to Award out next week.

There were allocation adjustments reducing our total by 1% from \$9,935,008 to \$9,935,008.

On the NOVA email, awardees were asked to accept or reject.

4. Community College (CC) SWP

Projects have been selected for the base funding. The Incentive Funding will be announced soon and the Spending Plan will be adjusted to include the Incentive funding. All of the Incentive funding is distributed to the districts for activities that align with the regional plan.

Luann will reiterate the lack of communication from the Chancellor's Office. Even though there is a long list of recipients on their memos, Deans and Regional Chairs are not getting these communications.

5. Review SWP and Perkins Timeline

Key events include the region's college CEO meeting on 2.28.20 and they will be reviewing the Governance Structure, Budget Parameters and Regional Plan Update that was submitted in January.

Informational items to them include K12 SWP updates, communications issues at the Chancellor's Office and Steering Committee recommendations if the SWP budget were to be reduced.

- Many will be attending CCCAOE in Sacramento.
- The April 17 Regional meeting in Ventura will include project updates and planning.
- May 1 Regional meeting will be at LinkedIn in Carpinteria.





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- The June Cambria retreat is beginning to be planned and there is a request for Job Developer professional development during the Retreat. We will be looking for volunteers to serve on the planning team— volunteers on the call included: Celine Park, Holly Chavez and Michael Specchierla, Laurie Arnold, Keri Aaver and Debbie Newcomb.

SCCRC Business/Updates

1. Program Recommendations/Notices of Intent (NOI)

Luann briefly explained the process and for the Deans to expect emails from the online system to vote on programs currently under review.

Harriet mentioned that College of the Canyons will have several NOIs in March.

2. Regional Chair Update

Business has been about K12 Strong Workforce, Perkins V and college SWP as well as reminding the Chancellor's Office about the need for better communications.

3. Key Talent Updates

Mike Bastine reported that he has been supporting Ventura College in getting a 100-hour pre-apprenticeship curriculum in machining. Employers will be coming on to interview the students and bring them on as apprentices.

Holly Chavez reported that the Perkins March 6th consultation group meeting still needs more industry partners. Holly is working with Ag faculty at Cuesta.

Harriet requested to see the list of participants as well as those who have been invited. Amanda will send the list out today. The list will also be attached to the updated flyer to go out in today's email. The work group has created a google document that will go out in a survey to industry in the region and can be used locally.

The Perkins application will be in NOVA. The Chancellor's Office has announced that they will do training for input to NOVA on the Friday afternoon as CCCAOE ends— Friday, March 13th. Luann mentioned that there will likely be an update at next week's Extended Ops meeting.

Adeline mentioned that Santa Barbara City College has begun a virtual internship program and will also be kicking off at Moorpark College. May 1st will be Bridge to Global Future event at Santa Barbara City College.





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4. California Community College Association for Occupational Education (CCCAOE) Update

The hotels are almost fully booked for CCCAO conference. The Hyatt is sold out, but the Radisson has space available. There is still an opportunity to see the Golden State Stadium on Monday and Advocacy Day on Tuesday.
