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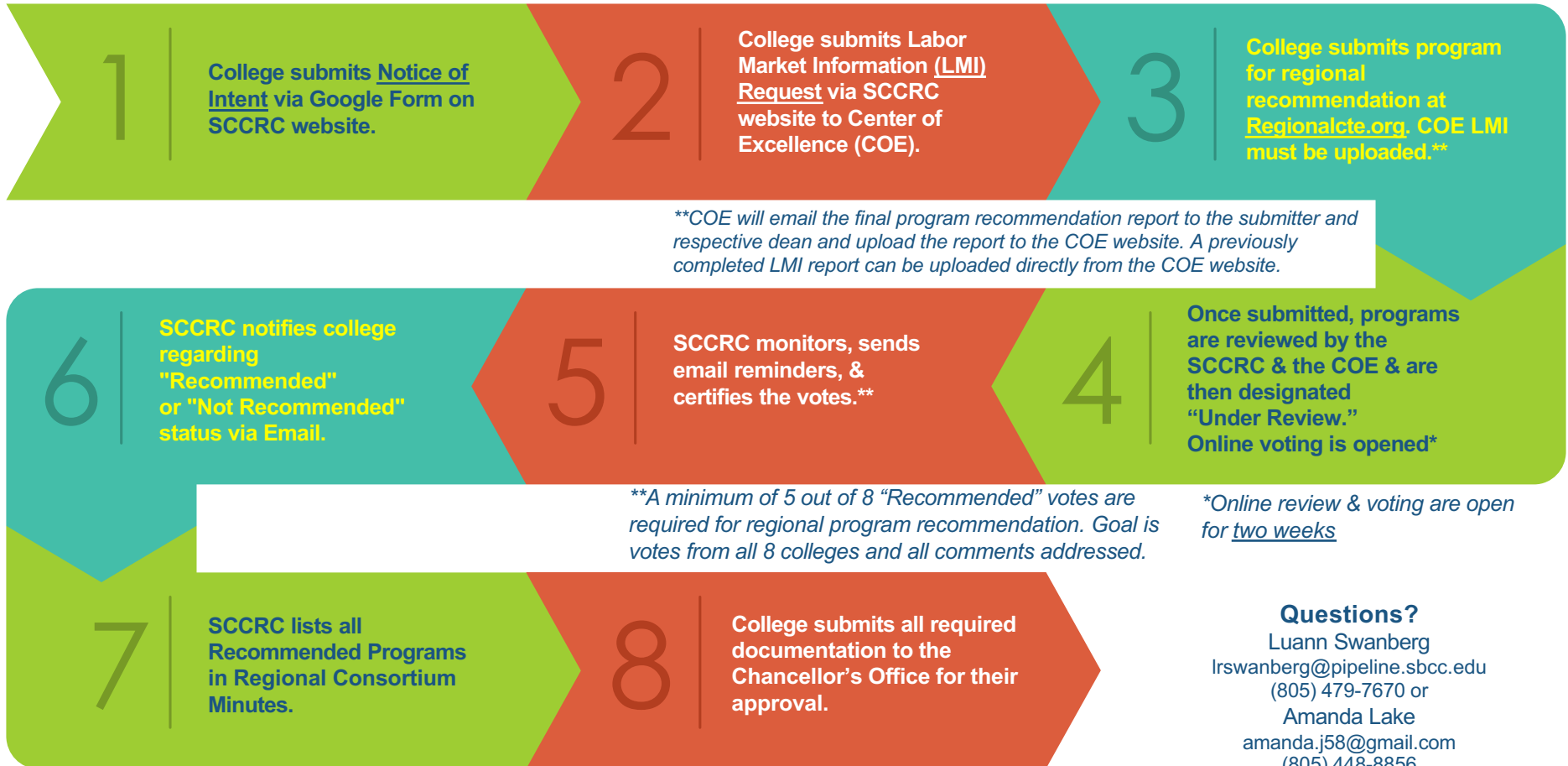

LMI Request Process

Step 2: Request Labor Market Information from the Center of Excellence (COE)

LMI Data Request Form

The PCAH 7th Edition (page 93) states: “Pursuant to Education Code § 78015 Labor Market Information (LMI) data is specifically required for all new CTE program proposals, where available. Current LMI and analysis, or other comparable information, must show that jobs are available for program completers within the local service area of the individual college and/or that job enhancement or promotion justifies the proposed curriculum. Regional, statewide, or national labor market evidence may be included as supplementary support, but evidence of need in the specific college service area or region is also necessary.”

The Chancellor’s Office and the SCCRC rely on consistent LMI data provided by the region’s Center of Excellence (COE) in order to make a recommendation for program approval. A Program Recommendation Report that is **NO MORE THAN TWO YEARS OLD** is required from the Center of Excellence. This report needs to be uploaded to the Program Submission page on the [RegionalCTE](#) website. At their discretion, colleges may submit other LMI data in addition to the LMI provided by the COE.

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ADVANCED MANUFACTURING AND LOGISTICS JOBS AND WAGES


The following table lists the **minimum** educational attainment that an individual needs to have in order to be qualified for the occupation. Wages listed for each occupation are based on 25th percentile to 75th percentile earnings, which represent wages from entry-level to experienced workers, respectively. **Only occupations with median earnings of at least \$15.38 per hour (i.e., living wage) and a labor market demand of at least 50 annual job openings are included in this list.** Any job with "All Other" in the title is an occupation with highly specialized subsets; put differently, the title is written broadly to capture various emerging occupations.

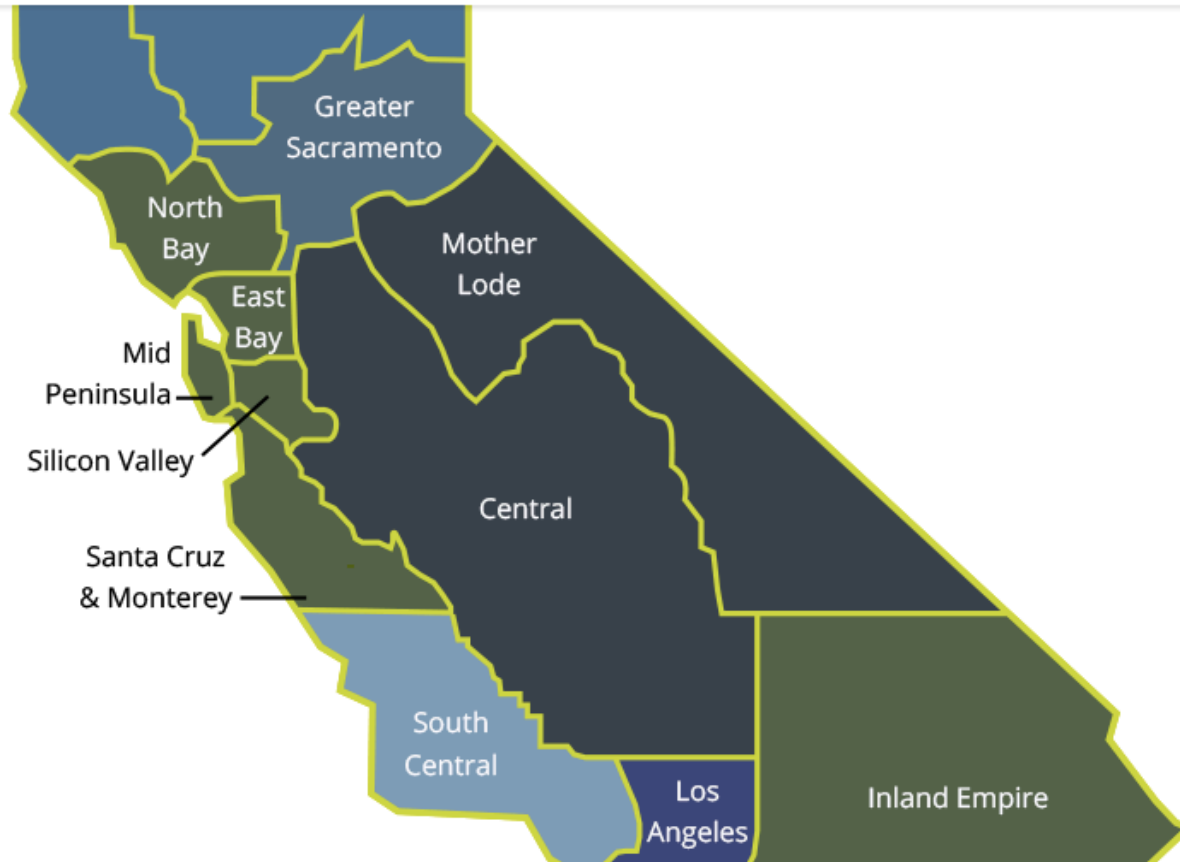
