3. Special Presentation: Contract Education - Not for Credit Options for the Region

Dave Teasdale, Prop 39 Director, and Regional Director of Energy, Construction and Utilities (PPT presentation <u>here</u>)

- a) Not-for-credit training under-utilized in the system.
- b) Example --Facilities Management Certificate at College of the Canyons is being developed as a credit and/or noncredit certificate. To begin, it will be offered as contract ed with incumbent workers.

- d) For Regional Directors and Job Developers when talking with employers, could use the toolkit. This will also be useful for introducing the concept to faculty.
- e) Let Dave Teasdale know if you are interested in working on the Resource and Toolkit. Also, let the Contract Ed group know who is responsible for Contract Ed on your campus.
- f) Harriet Happel shared that noncredit and contract ed should not operate in siloes. The college must speak to industry with one voice. Contract ed is the best place to do innovation work leading to noncredit and credit. Faculty must be involved from the beginning.
- g) Dave Teasdale added that contract ed must not "live" apart from the college. The toolkit will help in laying out the way to move contract ed onto noncredit and/or credit.

 - a) Chat: From Diane Walker to Everyone: Robert, you are probably aware, but ACTE has a whole initiative to IAED (inclusion, access, equity and diversity) perhaps they would like to participate, also?

 - 1. Luann reported on the Extended Operations meeting held on 5.13.21.

 - 2. Update on the competitive Request for Applications (RFA) for the regions. Luann went over the <u>PPT shared by Sheneui Weber</u>. The Economic and Workforce Development (EWD) funds that are being re-directed to the regions--\$1.1 million to SCCRC. The RFA is supposed to be released in early June.
 - 3. There are several other upcoming grants are any colleges on the call involved in High Road Training Partnership grants. COC is attending meetings put on by CA Workforce Development Board.
 - 4. Diane Walker mentioned that the Antelope Valley area is working on apprenticeship grants. The Ventura District and Cuesta (as well as SLOCOE) has a California Apprenticeship Initiative (CAI) grant.
 - a) Chat: From Felicia Duenas to Everyone: VCCCD has CAI grants
 - b) Chat: From Janine Medina to Everyone: Cuesta has a CAI grant
 - c) Chat: From Diane Walker to Everyone: AV TAPP grant for teacher prep pipeline with AVC, and we are also working on some for advanced manufacturing, IT/Cyber, and would like to get some for health care if/when available.
 - d) Chat: From Gayla Jurevich to Everyone: SLO area has several preapprenticeships & apprenticeships. Cuesta & SLOCOE
 - 5. Luann and Harriet mentioned that the Employer Engagement workgroup will be concentrating on the next Perkins Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment and

working with Robin Harrington. <mark>Drew LaFave, Robert Cabral and Mike Hoffman</mark> would like to be included in the work group.

- c) Center of Excellence
 - 1. Adele Hermann was not present, but Luann told the group that she can pull data needed for program recommendations.
 - 2. Program recommendations and LMI data needed for Round 5 SWP Plans in NOVA.
 - 3. Adele and Dave Teasdale are working together on a study of labor market needs for the construction industry for incumbent workers and upskilling.
 - 4. There was <u>Launchboard update</u> at the Extended Ops meeting. Let Luann know if you need Launchboard training.
 - 5. See Laura Coleman's document with link to webinar embedded at "<u>Examining the</u> <u>Living Wage in California</u>"
 - 6. Robert mentioned that that Adele's bandwidth is limited by funding. She does have a part-time researcher beginning soon.
- d) Regional Directors
 - 1. Business and Entrepreneurship Sector Gayla Jurevich
 - a) Nexus Edge now in Antelope Valley and Oxnard high school districts. Four of our colleges have implemented and some students have been interviewed by Citibank.
 - b) The Disney training went well and there might be a follow-up regarding Employee Engagement.
 - 2. Advanced Manufacturing Sector Mike Bastine
 - a) Proceeding with Ventura County Industry Council (VCIC)
 - b) There is a Ventura Avenue project working with businesses and unemployed and under-employed learning basic manufacturing skills.
 - c) There will be a Summer Institute at COC for middle school students to be exposed to STEM. SLO Partners Mechatronics training.
 - 3. <u>Agriculture, Water, and Environmental Technology Sector Holly Nolan-Chavez</u>
 - a) Chef Ann Foundation pilot program offering paid internships and work experience placing them in K12 kitchens. Seeking private foundation funding as well as state funding for the endeavor. Would like to scale statewide and nationally. This is a great way for displaced hospitality workers.
 - b) She is working with a work-based learning app which will be launched soon. Students can do virtual job shadow and career exploration.
 - c) She is hosting a statewide Ag Business advisory group.
 - d) Statewide agriculture deans meeting on Monday, May 17.
 - 4. <u>Health Sector Irene Ornelas</u>
 - a) Collaborating with CSU partners to strengthen nursing and alignment with clinical placements.
 - b) Professional development for Allied Health faculty there is a certified nurse educator training that also preps for the exam on May 28th.



- c) Through Kaiser Permanente grant a Behavioral Health toolkit for ROP being developed. There are 2 from high school, 2 from community college and industry participating.
- d) There is an implicit bias series happening with the last training in July.
- 5. <u>Dave Teasdale</u>
 - a) There will be another cohort of training for construction instructors –National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER).
- e) Joint Special Population Advisory Committee (JSPAC)
 - 1. Drew reported that there was a meeting at the end of April and he will share the PPT slides if requested about DEI the root of well-being of the organization.
 - 2. May is Asian/Pacific Islander month.

5. <u>SWP updates</u>

- a) Round 6 is expected to be released in June 2021.
- b) Quarter 3 SWP reports are due on May 15 for Round 4.
- c) For Round 5 only Quarter 2 and 4 reports required.
- d) In the Fall there will be no need to certify and uncertify plans in NOVA to make budget changes for 10% or under. The Chancellor's Office monitors still have to approve.

<u>K12 SWP</u>

- a) Currently recruiting for the Round 4 Selection Committee—must be approved by the Review Team.
- b) Robert Cabral has agreed to Chair the Selection Committee again.
- c) Round 4 will be released in early September with start date in January 2022.
- d) Giselle Bice shared the tentative timeline for Round 4. Extended the Selection Committee applications to May 16th. The mandatory dates for onboarding are being developed.
 - 1. Chat: From Laurie Arnold, VCOE to Everyone: Thanks Giselle, this is very helpful. My request is to offer the microregion sessions as far in advance of the application deadline as possible. Thanks for all consideration!

- d) Currently, there are no SCCRC meetings scheduled beyond June as we use that meeting to set the upcoming schedule.
- e) Felicia Duenas asked about the Regional Directors' contracts ending in December the Regions are receiving EWD funds to support Employer Engagement.
- f) Monica Phillippe offered thanks to the Regional Directors who have been very involved in 24 K12 advisory groups.

- g) <u>Fall return to in-person</u>:
 - 1. <u>Allan Hancock</u> has created an in-person Fall schedule, but they have a "ghost online schedule." Faculty can choose their modality.
 - 2. <u>COC</u>—the business department chose to keep just online. They have a one-day a week in-person and a two-day-a-week. Case by case basis. The labs are a big discussion. They think that Spring 2022 will be the big shift back.
 - 3. <u>SBCC</u> they are shooting for 40% of course offerings being in-person. For CTE 55% of course offerings will have all labs onsite. Some departments voluntarily requested to come back fully in-person. They are using Fall as transition in (more flexible). They are asking for volunteers to come back in-person. Spring will be fully on site. They are anticipating being able to operate under a 3-foot social distancing separation. Facilities personnel are removing one row—dropping from 30+ students down to 24.
 - 4. <u>Ventura District</u> Expectation is that all employees back on campus as of August 1st. At Ventura College, about 40% will have an in-person component. At Moorpark they are recommending that all personnel be vaccinated. The summer and fall schedules have been posted, so their caps are reflecting the 6-foot social distancing at this point, but are hoping for the 3-foot rule to go into effect in July. They will have large tents that can hold up to 60 students at a time on campus. At this point in time, Moorpark is about 35% in-person.
