Regional Fiscal Agent Director

- SCCRC CC & K12 SWP fiscal Agent
- NOVA fiscals, including Budget Modification and Capital Outlay

K14 TAP

- Regional programmatic support
- Development, administration, & organization of Pathway Improvement initiatives
- Trains SCCRC Selection Committee

K12 Pathway Coordinator

- Assigned to a CC service area
- Using a Grantee's Work Plan, aids the strengthening and expansion of K14 CTE programs

Center of Excellence

- Customized research, analysis of regional economic and workforce need
- Data supports community college decision making and curriculum planning

Elements of K12 SWP

Fiscal

- Approves, certifies Grant Plan in NOVA
- Enters into agreement with grantee
- Issues purchase orders, payments
- Reviews fiscal reporting
- Reviews, approves plan and budget modifications
- Sets processes for modifications, invoicing

Programmatic

- Facilitates training for K14 partners, PCs
- Solicits applications from K12, ROP, and Charter Schools
- Recruits, trains K12 Selection Committee members
- Supports grantee and PC outcomes using the Work Plan / SWP Metrics
