1. RECITALS

Addendum to the Master Agreement is entered into between Santa Barbara Community College District as Fiscal Agent and the above-named community college districts as subcontractors regarding Economic and Workforce Development (EWD) Funding to support employer engagement.

2. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The period of performance under this Addendum shall commence on January 1, 2022 and shall expire on June 30, 2023.

3. AWARD AMOUNT

Total award amount listed in the Regional Collaboration and Coordination Grant Request for Applications to the South Central Coast Regional Consortium for the EWD (Employer Engagement) funding is **\$ 1,668,903**. The FISCAL AGENT is authorized to receive a 4% indirect fee of **\$64,188**.

Therefore, the total amount for this Agreement to the Parties is not to exceed **\$1,604,715** and payment to each SUBCONTRACTOR shall be made in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement. Amounts to be paid to each community college district listed above are as follows:
