Spotlight on SCC Region Colleges



SBCC - SBCC launched an additional data and inquiry team focused on automotive technology: To increase course enrollment, retention, and completion rates for part time students, for age 18-25 year olds and female students by promoting the value of formalized automotive technical education. Example of how they plan to accomplish this work is through a new low unit certificate among other efforts.



Allan Hancock - AHC is working to integrate discipline faculty into all outreach and recruitment activities in an effort to fuse program recruitment and orientation (as opposed to college-only recruitment and orientation) into the process.



Cuesta - Cuesta hired a new Associate Dean of Student Equity & Guided Pathways. The focus of this role is to integrate these two statewide efforts. In partnership with the Student Equity Planning Institute (SEPI) Cuesta is receiving training & guidance from experts & fellow CCs on how to decrease their equity gaps through a GP framework.
