# State CTE Plan – College of the Canyons will host regional convening in August/September

The California State Plan for Career Technical Education (CTE) is a strategic plan and call to action that sets forth a student-centered vision for the future of high-quality CTE in the State of California. It provides a framework with key priorities and themes anchored in equity and access to achieve the vision for CTE. The plan includes long-term areas of focus, as well as four main goals for the next three years. The four core goals, to be pursued in tandem, are:

- Boost data-informed decision-making for equity and impact
- Expand work-based learning in all regions, with a focus on equity
- Grow dual enrollment in all regions, with a focus on equity
- Understand and plan to address CTE teacher and faculty shortages

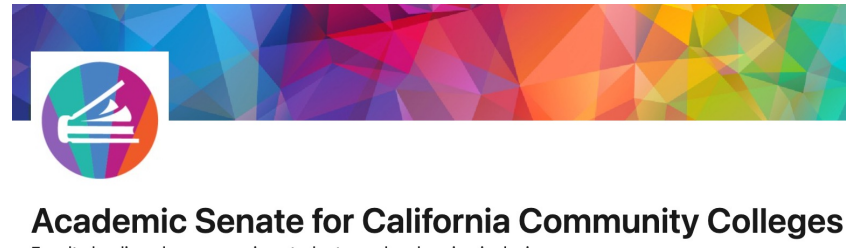
To support implementation of the California State Plan for Career Technical Education across the state's diverse regions, the CAST will organize up to 10 Regional Implementation Convenings. The series of events will span urban and rural areas across the Northern, Central, and Southern regions of the state. The objectives of the Regional Implementation Convenings are to:

- Build understanding and spur action on the California State Plan for Career Technical Education
- Support regional teams in implementation planning to strengthen and build on current efforts and strategically align programs and funding streams across sectors and institutions
- Engage in peer learning, idea sharing, and knowledge exchange

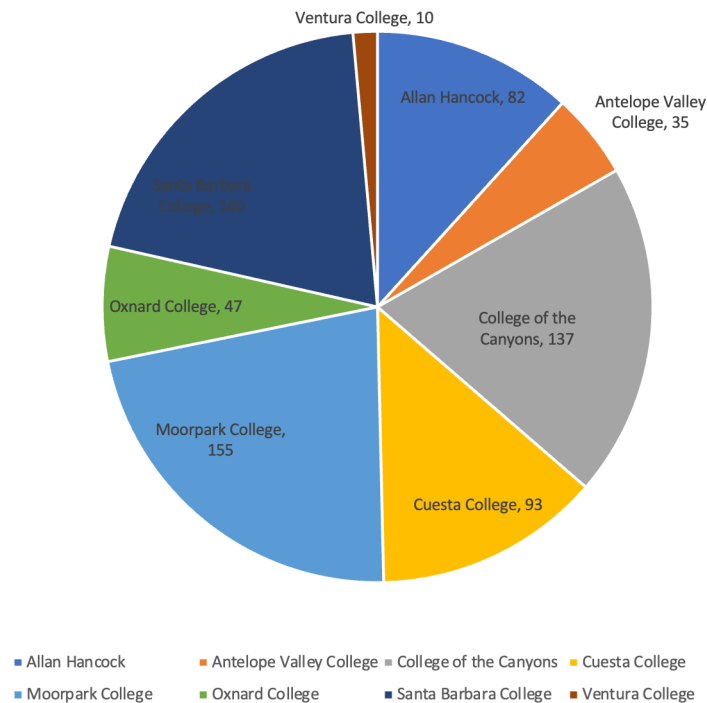


# Academic Senate Convening

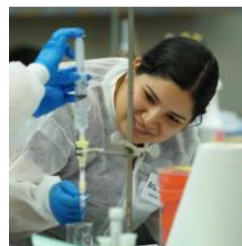
