❖ **Apprenticeship**

- **California Apprenticeship Initiative (CAI)**
 - The Foundation for California Community Colleges and the LAUNCH Apprenticeship Network have been contracted by the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office to provide technical assistance to apprenticeship and pre-apprenticeship programs. The Foundation will support general technical assistance needs and can be reached at apprenticeshipsupportnetwork@foundationccc.org, while LAUNCH will provide specialized support in areas such as employer engagement and program sponsorship at justin@launchapprenticeship.org.
 - The Apprenticeship Team will continue to meet twice monthly on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays from 2:00 – 3:00 p.m. Each focused session will provide a short overview of the topic, cover frequently asked questions, and open the floor for participant Q&A. General sessions remain open for any apprenticeship-related questions or technical assistance.

 - The California Community College Chancellor's Office, Foundation for California Community Colleges, Rancho Santiago Community College District, and LAUNCH Apprenticeship Network are hosting **the Statewide Convening on Community College Apprenticeship Program Creation & Expansion, March 19–20, 2026, in Costa Mesa, CA**. This engaging, informative two-day convening is designed to support California Community College apprenticeship stakeholders at all levels of designing, implementing, and expanding Registered Apprenticeship Programs that meet the state's evolving workforce needs.
 - Participants will have the opportunity to network with peers, hear about best and promising practices from subject-matter experts, use tools to support campus- and regional-level planning, and engage in conversations with employers.

- Please review the CCCC **Apprenticeship Course and Student Coding Guidance memo** carefully to ensure that apprenticeship and pre-apprenticeship courses and students are appropriately coded in your local systems. Accurate use of SAM course codes (e.g., CB09 = A for apprenticeship courses) and correct student apprenticeship status coding (SB23) is essential for reliable statewide reporting, compliance with funding rules, and proper alignment with DAS registration requirements. Misclassification can lead to reporting errors, missed funding opportunities, and challenges in measuring program outcomes.

❖ Strong Workforce Program (SWP)

- **AB 323 Direct Student Support**
 - Under AB 323, colleges may use SWP funds to provide direct financial support for paid WBL experiences, including apprenticeships, internships, externships, and student-run enterprises. These opportunities are intended to improve employability and employment outcomes for students enrolled in SWP. Colleges are encouraged to design programs that align with regional labor market needs and to prioritize equitable access for traditionally underrepresented and economically disadvantaged students.
 - **Guidance Memo released November 7, 2025.**
 - AB 323 applies to SWP only. K12 SWP is excluded.

 - FY 2024/25: Extensions are not being considered for the allocation expenditure timeframe. Funds expire on **6/30/2026**. Final fiscal reporting is **due by 8/15/2026**.

 For all out of state travel requests, please submit using the current the **Perkins Out-of-State Travel Request Authorization Form**. Requests for travel should be submitted for approval via email to your regional monitor once they contain sufficient detail to support a thorough review. This includes:
 - A clearly defined purpose for the out-of-state travel
 - How attendance will benefit CTE programs as shared in the local application
 - How attendance will benefit the State
 - An explanation for why the traveler cannot receive similar training or opportunities in the State

Including this information in travel requests is critical in providing the Chancellor’s Office with the necessary level of detail in case of an audit.
